

Academic Writing for International Journals

This workshop will introduce you to the conventions of English academic writing and show you how to craft a research article for publication in a peer-reviewed international journal.

You will learn an approach to uncovering the conventions of structure, organization, grammar and vocabulary in English academic writing in your field. You will learn how to identify and repair problems in your own writing, and how to structure your writing to make it easier for readers to follow.

You will also be introduced to a system of deliberate practice activities designed to help writers refine their skills.
